Nelson Property Permanently Protected 11/06/2023: This 120-acre homestead in
Montrose and Delta Counties was first settled in the 1880s. The property is used today
for livestock grazing and hay production, but many of the original structures are still
standing. The property is a mix of irrigated fields, sagebush, and pinyon-juniper trees,
with a half-mile frontage along Clear Fork Creek, sheltering Gunnison sage grouse,
balk eagle, black bear, elk, mountain lion and mule deer. This property joins more than
12,000 acres of conserved agricultural land within a 10-mile radius.

Gross Reservoir Updates https://www.denverwater.org/grossreservoir

Construction is underway. Construction for the Gross Reservoir Expansion Project started April 1, 2022. The project will raise the height of the dam by 131 feet, tripling the reservoir's capacity from approximately 42,000 acre-feet to 119,000 acre-feet. When complete, the reservoir, located in western Boulder County, will be Denver Water's second-largest and will provide essential flexibility and resiliency to our customers in the face of increasing impacts from climate change.
